

## PARISH HILL SPECTATOR PROTOCOLS & GUIDELINES FOR HOME SOCCER GAMES & CROSS COUNTRY MEETS

1. All spectators must self-screen prior to coming to a home game or meet. The self-screening questions can be found on the Parish Hill website. ([www.parishhill.org](http://www.parishhill.org)) Please substitute spectator for child.
2. All spectators must sign-in with the athletic director or his designee when they arrive at the site. Spectators will be asked to give their name and phone number. This information will be used in contact tracing, if necessary.
3. Maximum capacity for any home event is 50 spectators. No more than two (2) spectators, including children, per Home team participants.
4. No visiting team spectators are allowed.
5. Spectators must wear a mask or face covering at the field locations. Shirts and jackets will not be allowed as a face covering.
6. Spectators must socially distance (at least 6 feet) while in attendance.
7. At soccer games, spectators are not allowed within 12 yards of the field of play.
8. At cross country meets, spectators are only allowed at designated spots to view the meet. Masks must be worn and 6 foot social distancing must be maintained. At the finish line, spectators are not allowed within 10 yards of the finish line. Spectators are not allowed to interact with players and coaches at any time.
9. Following the completion of a game or meet, spectators are asked to leave the facility without interacting with the teams or the players.
10. Spectators not following the protocols and guidelines for the home site will be warned first. If they do not comply, they will be required to leave the facility.
11. Spectators are asked to respect all players, coaches, and officials. **Be a Fan....Not a Fanatic!** Work with us to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all.
12. Parish Hill Middle High School is closed to all spectators before, during, and after a home event. No one will be allowed in the school.
