Dear Parents/Guardians:

Early this morning, central office and school administration were notified that a member in our school community tested positive for COVID-19. We immediately contacted the Eastern Highlands Health District (EHHD) to determine next steps.

EHHD Health Director Robert Miller indicated that he directed all EHHD staff to investigate this fully to confirm all facts. The investigation phase was used to confirm any test results, communicate with parents/families, conduct contact tracing, and determine potential interactions with others in the school community. Once this data was acquired, the next step was to determine what action, if necessary, would take place. Please keep in mind that any action that district and school personnel take will be at the direction of our health experts at EHHD.

After an extensive investigation by EHHD, the EHHD Director determined later this afternoon that there is little or no risk to the school community at this time. The EHHD is still in the investigative process but they have assured us that no member of our school community was exposed during the window of infectivity. EHHD also confirmed that Parish Hill is employing highly effective mitigation procedures to minimize any risk of transmission.

Although we have been assured by EHHD that there is little or no risk to the school community at this time, we wanted to keep you informed and assure you that the safety and welfare of all students and staff will always be our highest priority.
