Dear Parents/Guardians:

With the holiday break just a day away and with some families considering out-of-state/country travel plans, we wish to remind you of Connecticut's COVID-19 quarantine and testing protocols, and which states they *may* apply to. Please keep in mind that this is an ever-changing picture as Connecticut adds some states and removes others due to up-to-date COVID-19 data. However, as of this date, virtually all states are on this list. Furthermore, our state Department of Health is encouraging only in-state travel and small family gatherings.

If you choose to travel over the coming weeks, the Connecticut Department of Public Health and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have updated travel regulations.
