All responses must be printed and signed with contractor name, address, and phone number. Each proposal must be original and hard copy, and signed by the owner, or highest-ranking member in the contractor's firm. Fax copies at 860-455-1263 are acceptable.

Copies of Proposal: The contractor shall submit the original signed proposal and one complete signed copy of proposal.

Opening of Proposal: The quotes will be publicly opened at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 21 at 4:00 p.m. in the Superintendent's Office, 304 Parish Hill Road, Chaplin, CT 06235.

Contractor Requirements/ Responsibilities

Snow removal contractor must be available at the contractors pricing 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays.

The contractor will be responsible for clearing snow and ice and applying salt/sand in all parking lots, loading docks, and all driveways on the Parish Hill grounds.

Prior to the first snowfall, the Contractor shall inspect all areas for its borders, curbing, hedges and pipes.

The contractor will need to mark and identify all permanent hazards including posts, power outlets, and signage with bright colored stakes.

The contractor will push all snow to areas designated by the RSD 11 Maintenance Director. If snow is pushed or plowed into inappropriate areas, the contractor will remove the snow at the contractor's expense

When snow drifts occur, the contractor will be required to maintain all areas to assure maximum safety for facility users.

Salt/ sand must be applied 1 hour prior to the start of school.

The salting and sanding of any sidewalks and turnaround sidewalks will not be required be the contractor.

Exception: If directed by the RSD Maintenance Director to perform any clearing and applying any ice melt to sidewalks with use of the contractor's vehicles, only then will contractor rates apply.

Service, Equipment, and Supplies Provided by Contractor

Provide a list of all service vehicles that will be used to perform the snow removal and salting and sanding of lots.

100% of all equipment, labor, equipment maintenance

Ice melt/ salt/ sand mix
